Mike G. started in Al-Anon in 1987 and has been sober and active in Alcoholics Anonymous since 1992. He is a nationally famous author and journalist, and writes books about recovery for Hazelden under the pseudonym Michael Graubart. He also uses that name as a singer/songwriter, to adhere to the Tradition of anonymity and to be able to write freely about the inner experience of recovery.

This concert is the world premiere of Mike's 13 "Sober Songs" -- which range from rock to folk to country to smooth jazz and everything in between.

The concert is free but it is suggested to arrive early to get a seat as seating is strictly limited to 90 attendees. Some of the songs have adult themes and language; the event would not be appropriate for younger children.
